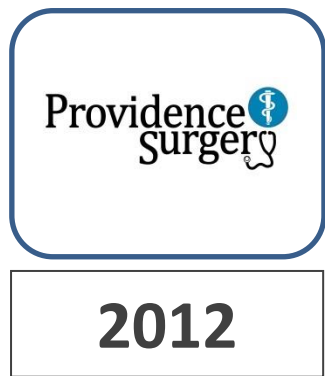


Patient consultation on South Coast Medical Group: Nov 2018

Over the past five years, Dr Mufeed Ni'man and his team, initially under the name of Providence Surgery, have developed from a single practice site, serving five thousand patients, to seven sites, serving over 30,000 patients, through merging with Strouden Park Surgery, Crescent Surgery and The Village Medical Practice and integrating with The Grove Surgery, Marine Surgery and Oakridge Surgery. Additionally, New Waves Integrated Care provides the Walk-in Service at Boscombe and Springbourne Health Centre. We believe that in working at scale, in line with the NHS Five Year Forward Plan, we are better able to provide the very best care for our patients sustainably. Benefits to patients include increased access to a wide range of non-NHS funded services, including diagnostics not usually provided in primary care.
